

ERASMUS + ACTIVITIES- Learning outside: 2nd grade



The pupils of the 2nd grade went to the school yard to learn about the environment and Maths.

They made small groups and each group was given instructions, what to do.

The tasks were as follows:

- 1) They had to fill three cups with the same amount of snow:

- first they had to stuff the snow

- they had to fill the cup without stuffing the snow



- 3) They measured the amount of snow using a stick.

- 4) They answered the following question: »What is the outside temperature today?

- 5) They observed and listened to the environment around them. They named the creatures they saw or heard.

The tasks outside were furtherly discussed and analysed in the classroom. The pupils have realized that the first cup held the most water after the snow melted. However, the amount of water was smaller than the amount of snow. They have also discovered that the snow melted the quickest in a tin cup. They have learnt about the different state of water.
